

Parables: Christianity. Instructions: Cut up the sentences found on pp.1 and 2. Ask pupils to discuss them and sequence them (then use the power point to check answers)

The story of Moses is told in	the Bible, Torah and Qur'an.

Pharaoh did not listen to Moses	so God sent 10 plagues to Egypt.

After the 10 th plague, Pharaoh told Moses	to take the Israelites out of Egypt.
Moses told the people to	leave quickly.
The people left so quickly that their bread had	no time to rise.
Pharaoh changed his mind and sent 500	horsemen to bring the slaves back.
Moses parted the sea and the Israelites walked	across it safely but the horsemen drowned.
At the top of Mount Sinai, God gave Moses 10	Commandments for the people to live by.
Moses led the Israelite slaves	to freedom in another country.
